

फीस रिफंड हेतु नियम

संशोधित (दिनांक 08.02.2023 से 15.02.2023)

पी.टी.ई.टी.-2022 चार वर्षीय बी.ए. बी.एड/बी.एस.सी. बी.एड. पाठ्यक्रम एवं दो वर्षीय बी.एड.पाठ्यक्रम में प्रवेश हेतु काउंसलिंग में भाग लेने वाले निम्नलिखित अभ्यर्थी/विद्यार्थी फीस रिफंड के पात्र हैं:-

1. अभ्यर्थी जिन्हें महाविद्यालय आवंटन नहीं हुआ/महाविद्यालय आवंटन हो गया हो परन्तु महाविद्यालय में रिपोर्टिंग नहीं हुई हो।
2. प्रवेशित विद्यार्थी/अभ्यर्थी जिनका रजिस्ट्रेशन शुल्क 5000/- अथवा प्रवेश शुल्क 22000/- के एक से अधिक शुल्क जमा हुए हैं।
3. विद्यार्थी जिनका प्रवेश काउंसलिंग के तहत हुआ था परन्तु अपवर्ड मूवमेंट के तहत आवंटित महाविद्यालय में प्रवेश नहीं लिया है।
4. विद्यार्थी जिनकी प्रवेश के पश्चात् मृत्यु हो गई हो (विद्यार्थी के परिजन को विद्यार्थी का मृत्यु प्रमाण-पत्र एवं महाविद्यालय प्रवेश रद्द पुष्टि रसीद प्रस्तुत करनी होगी)।
5. विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग, नई दिल्ली के कार्यालय आदेश D.O.No.2-71/2022 (CPP-II) dated 2nd August, 2022 एवं D.O.No.2-71/2022 (CPP-II) dated 1st November, 2022 के तहत चार वर्षीय बी.ए. बी.एड/बी.एस.सी. बी.एड. पाठ्यक्रम एवं दो वर्षीय बी.एड. पाठ्यक्रम महाविद्यालय में प्रवेश होने के पश्चात् अन्य पाठ्यक्रम में प्रवेश लिया है या अन्य किसी कारणवश महाविद्यालय से प्रवेश रद्द करवाया है (विद्यार्थी को महाविद्यालय से प्रवेश रद्द पुष्टि रसीद देनी होगी)।
6. फीस रिफंड के पात्र अभ्यर्थी दिनांक 08.02.2023 से 15.02.2023 तक पीटीईटी-2022 की अधिकृत वेबसाइट www.ptetraj2022.com एवं www.ptetraj2022.org पर Apply for Refund Option पर क्लिक कर अपने पीटीईटी-2022 के रोल नम्बर, काउंसलिंग आईडी जो अभ्यर्थी के पीटीईटी-2022 के परीक्षा परिणाम में दर्शित है, स्वयं का नाम, पिता का नाम, माता का नाम तथा जन्म तिथि से लॉगिन कर स्वयं अपने बैंक खाते का सम्पूर्ण विवरण यथा खाता संख्या, बैंक का IFSC कोड, बैंक पासबुक/चैक बुक तथा स्वयं का पता संबंधित दस्तावेज यथा आधार कार्ड/ड्राईविंग लाइसेंस/वोटर आईडी कार्ड, फीस जमा चालान की प्रतिलिपी एवं ट्रांजेक्शन आई.डी. आवश्यक रूप से अपलोड करें।
7. शुल्क रिफंड संबंधित समस्त कार्य ऑनलाईन आवेदन के अनुसार ही होगा। इस हेतु पीटीईटी कार्यालय में अनावश्यक व्यक्तिगत सम्पर्क करने की आवश्यकता नहीं है।
8. रिफंड केवल अभ्यर्थी के स्वयं/पिता/माता व आवेदन करने वाले बैंक खाते में ही किया जायेगा। जिसकी सम्पूर्ण जिम्मेदारी अभ्यर्थी की स्वयं की होगी।
9. जिन अभ्यर्थियों का प्रवेश किसी भी महाविद्यालय में कन्फर्म हो गया है, वे फीस रिफंड के पात्र नहीं हैं।

Respected Madam/Sir,

The Commission has received references in the form of RTI applications/ complaints/ public grievances/ court cases regarding non-refund fees by some universities/institutions violating the UGC Guidelines / Notifications. The Commission has taken a serious view of such complaints.

It is reiterated that the UGC letter dated 02.08.2022 (**Annexure**) is to be mandatorily adhered to in letter and spirit. Any institution/ university found to be violating the guidelines and refusing to refund the fee by giving its interpretation of the Guidelines / Notifications shall be liable for punitive actions as notified in clause 5 of the UGC Notification regarding the refund of fees and non-retention of original certificate issued in October 2018 (https://www.ugc.ac.in/pdfnews/5437737_UGC-Notice-reg-Fees-refund-Eng.pdf) as reproduced below:

1. withdrawal of declaration of fitness to receive grants under Section 12B of the UGC Act, 1956;
2. withholding any grant allocated to the HEI;
3. declaring the HEI ineligible for consideration for any assistance under any of the general or special assistance programs of the Commission;
4. informing the general public, including potential candidates for admission, through a notice displayed prominently in the newspapers or other suitable media and posted on the website of the Commission about the non-compliance by the HEI concerned;
5. recommend to the affiliating university for withdrawal of affiliation, in case of a college/institute;
6. recommend to the Central Government for withdrawal of declaration as Institution deemed to be a university, in case of an institution deemed to be a university;
7. recommend to the appropriate State Government for appropriate necessary action in case of a university is established or incorporated under a State Act;
8. taking such other action within its powers as the Commission may deem fit.

You are again requested to ensure compliance with the UGC directions regarding the refund of fees and return of the original document to the students.

Subject: Fee refund policy 2022-2023

Respected Madam/Sir,

As you are aware that the University Grants Commission has issued 'the UGC guidelines on examination and academic calendar in view of the Covid-19 pandemic' on 16th July, 2021, wherein UGC has stipulated the provision of refund of fees on account of all cancellations of admissions/ migrations of students during the academic session 2021-2022. Also, UGC on 12th July, 2022 has requested the higher educational institutions to fix the last date of their under graduate admission process after declaration of result of class XII by CBSE so as to provide sufficient time to such students for admission in under graduate courses. Also, it may be noted that several entrance examinations including CUET, JEE Main, JEE Advance etc. have been delayed, due to which admissions may continue up to October, 2022.

In view above, and in order to avoid financial hardships being faced by parents, it has been decided by UGC that full refund of fees should be made by the higher educational institutions on account of all cancellations of admissions/ migrations of students up to October 31, 2022 for the academic session 2022- 2023 as a special case. It is made clear that the entire fee, including all charges, should be refunded (i.e., there should be zero cancellation charges) on account of cancellations/ migrations up to October 31, 2022. Thereafter, on cancellation/ withdrawal of admissions up to December 31, 2022, the entire fee collected from a student should be refunded in full after deducting not more than Rs.1000/- as processing fee.

All the Higher Educational Institutions are requested to ensure the compliance of the UGC directions in respect of refund of fee in view of COVID-19 Pandemic related factors.

GENERAL GUIDELINES & RULES

PRE-TEACHER EDUCATION TEST-2022

For admission to B.Ed. Course, session 2022-23 in various Teacher Training institutions in the State of Rajasthan, a competitive test for selection of candidates i.e., Pre-Teacher Education Test (PTET) will be conducted by Jai Narain Vyas University, Jodhpur, Rajasthan, according to the following rules as approved by the Government of Rajasthan:

RULES FOR ADMISSION TO B.Ed. COURSE (Two years)

1. There will be a Pre-Teacher Education Test hereinafter called PTET-2022 for admission to B.Ed. Colleges of Rajasthan. **On-Line Application Forms** for the same are being invited by Jai Narain Vyas University, Jodhpur, RAJ. Candidates securing at least 50% marks in aggregate in the Bachelor's / Master's Degree examination of any State University or any other University recognized as equivalent to and fulfilling the other requirements for admission to B.Ed. course prescribed hereinafter will be eligible to apply for admission to B.Ed. Course through PTET. However, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, MBC as well as physically challenged and Widow or Divorced women candidates of Rajasthan having at least 45% marks in aggregate in the Bachelor's or Master's degree level examination will be eligible to apply for admission. No relaxation in the minimum percentage (not even 1 mark), as required above, will be given to any candidate.
2. Candidates who have passed Graduation through Correspondence Course from any University by taking only one University Examination (One/Single sitting), even if they have cleared PG degree on the basis of this degree, are not eligible to appear in PTET; candidates who have not studied through 10+2+3 scheme or 10+1+3 (old scheme) are also not eligible to appear in PTET.
3. Those who are appearing in the qualifying examination i.e. B.A./B.Com./B.Sc./Shastri Final year and/or M.A./M.Com./M.Sc./Acharya Final year may also apply and appear in the PTET-2022 subject to the condition that they should have their result up to the last date of online counseling registration and have Marks Sheet of the qualifying examination with eligibility percentage and the candidates should have registered themselves online and participated in online counseling. It is clarified that any other document in the shape of provisional certificate and/or newspapers cutting, result/marks-sheet obtained through the internet, etc., will not be acceptable. Any false information provided by the candidate while participating in the test/counseling regarding their result/percentage of marks obtained will result in depriving them of admission in B.Ed. Course and fee submitted by them will not be refunded.
4. Based on the performance in the PTET, a merit list showing the marks obtained by each candidate will be prepared.

5. A registration amount for online counseling will be Rs. 5000/-. This amount will be adjusted in overall fee in the case, the candidate joins the allotted college through online counseling, else, (1) Rs 200 will be deducted In case of nonreporting of candidate (2) Rs 600 will be deducted if a candidate deposits the fee but does not join the college.

6. Out of the total number of seats available in each Faculty (Arts, Science, and Commerce), reservation for Rajasthan domicile only will be made as given here under as per state govt. rules:

I	For candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes	16%
II	For candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes	12%
III	For candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes	21%
IV	For candidates belonging to MBC.	5 %
V	For women (out of which 8% seats are reserved for widows and 2% for divorced women)	(As per Govt. Reservation Rules)
VI	For physically challenged (blind, deaf and/ or dumb and orthopedic) with at least 40% disability, on the production of a medical certificate on Form No.4, will have to be submitted duly signed by medical Board or by Reader in the speciality concerned where there is a medical college or from the junior Specialist in the speciality concerned or the C.M.H.Os. at a place where there no Medical College exists.	05%
VII	For in-service or an Ex-serviceman defence personnel or for his/her ward (only Air force, Army, and Navy personnel)	05%
VIII	Economically Weaker Section (EWS)	10%

Notes on the above rules

- a. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, and Most Backward classes of Rajasthan shall be required to produce a Certificate (As per govt. admission policy) to that effect from a District Magistrate/Sub-Division Magistrate/Tehsildar.
- b. Candidates belonging to the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) are required to produce an Income and Asset certificate to that effect from competent authority as per rules of the Government of Rajasthan.
- c. The Term 'Wards' means only the son, daughter, wife or husband; real sister and real brother may also be treated wards of defence personnel, provided they are dependent on the guardian concerned and parents are not alive.
- d. Divorced woman shall be required to produce a certificate in the shape of the decision of the Court to the effect that she has been divorced, and an affidavit to the effect that she has not married again, duly attested by Notary. The certificate issued by any social organization will not be entertained.
- e. For defence personnel/wards, a certificate issued by the Major of the Unit/Secretary, Soldiers Board as per rules will have to be produced, failing which, the benefit under this category will not be granted. B.S.F. C.R.P.F. and other territorial force personnel and their wards are not covered under this category.
